Overarching title: Efficient syntheses of bioactive natural products and their analogues

Universities involved: Universities of Freiburg, Strasbourg, Nagoya and Stellenbosch (host)

Executive summary:

Where there is [an academic] will, there is a way! In early 2021, AC21 funding was received for a project involving the four Universities of Freiburg, Strasbourg, Nagoya and Stellenbosch, with the original plans spanning the timeframe March 2021 to May 2022. However, lockdown and travel restrictions due to the Covid-19 pandemic meant that organization of these AC21-funded interactions was severely affected. Due to travel restrictions, in 2021 (October) and early 2022 (February), only two well attended online Postgraduate & Postdoctoral events could be organized (~ 50 participants each). Finally in December 2022, members from three of the four AC21-affiliated universities involved were able to meet for a series of three very well-received morning symposia at the Universities of Cape Town, the Western Cape and Stellenbosch (with a combined attendance number of ~150 attendees over the 3 day events). This document provides a report-back in terms of what was achieved through the AC21 funding received, of which ~80% of the budget was spent. A request is tabled to the AC21 to allow the remaining 20% to be utilized for Stellenbosch students and academics in terms of "return" visits to the Universities of Freiburg, Strasbourg and Nagoya.
